Re.: RoHS II compliance (Directive 2011/65/EU)


Dear Sirs,

According to the RoHS Directive 2002/95/EEC Manufactures must ensure that from July 1st, 2006 new electrical and electronic equipment put on the market does not contain more than 0,1 weight percentage lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and 0,01 weight percentage cadmium per homogeneous material.

All Klauke/Greenlee/Tempo products impacted by the RoHS II directive and it's amendments except those in category 9 which are exempt are compliant from July 1st, 2006. Please note that the RoHS directive is enabled to prevent the manufacturer/importer to produce/sell non-compliant products after July 1st, 2006.
